Since then he has placed multiple MACHs on different dogs. He also tried out for the AKC World Team in 2009, 2010, and 2014. Currently, Mike is a student at the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities studying Animal Science. He plans to become a Certified Canine Rehabilitation Practitioner after his undergrad degree. Mike was recently named to the 2014 AKC European Open Team and placed 2nd overall in the 12" division at the 2013 AKC National Agility Championships in Tulsa, OK.

The day will be spent learning basic elements as well as learning how to chain elements together. It will be a great event for all skill levels from beginner to advanced. The cost of \$25 will include instruction and lunch. The event will be held at the Iron Range Dog Training Club in Virginia, located in the Thunderbird Mall.
