


CISS.Tabs Module


1. Add the module to your page.




2. The first pencil is for Manage Tab. The second pencil is for the Tab List.
3. The Manage Tab is settings for all tabs. You can set the width of the tab.



4. The tab list is where you will add the tabs and the content for the tabs.




5. Start by clicking on "Add A New Tab".
 - a. Tab Name: The name that will appear on the tab
 - b. Disabled: This will make the tab not work. It is still visible.
 - c. Content Type
 - i. TextEditor: This is the equivalent of Text/HTML Module
 - ii. Existing Module: This creates a snapshot of a module already on the website.
 - iii. XML+XSL: Can be used for simple RSS reader.
 - d. Tab Type
 - i. Enable Ajax: Check this option when you think other tabs may have large image or text content that can reduce loading time.
 - ii. Active by MouseHover: Select this if you'd like the user to go to that tab when they mouse over the tab.



e. Editor – this is the same as Text/HTML module
