VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES:			
<p>Incredible Exchange students will assist at day camps, birthday parties, or neighborhood programming (in Gary New Duluth, Spirit Valley, Lincoln Park, and possibly one other site (at the shelter is a possibility). They will assist campers with the daily camp program and activities at the shelter, assist staff at the neighborhood sites with animal-related activities, art projects, and other things (it will be like having offsite camps!), or help manage the fun activities at birthday parties. Experience having an animal in your life will be important. We may take part in parades over the summer!</p>			
SCHEDULING AND AVAILABILITY			
<p>Schedule will be determined in the orientation onsite. There are not camps every week, there will be neighborhood programs on three afternoons per week, birthday parties are as scheduled. If you are traveling a lot this summer, you may not have time to commit and get all of your hours you contract for within the summer timeframe. You also will need transportation to the shelter for camps and parties and transportation to and from the neighborhood sites.</p>

<p>Youth must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be comfortable around dogs and cats. • Be an independent, mature and a task-oriented thinker. • Be dependable and show up for assigned shifts. • Follow safety precautions. • Following directions and understanding procedures with animals is a must! • Be comfortable communicating with shelter staff, campers, other volunteers, and follow the direction of lead volunteers or staff. 			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Should not have allergies to dogs and cats. • Must attend a site orientation • Reliable transportation and prompt pick up are a must. • Must have health insurance and be up-to-date on tetanus shots.
