

**NOTICE OF FILING FOR THE 2016
STATE GENERAL ELECTION
ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MINNESOTA**

Notice is hereby given that the state General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016. The filing period for United States Representative, State Senator, State Representative, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Judge of the Minnesota Court of Appeals, Judge of the District Court, County Commissioner, and North and South Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisors begins at 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 17, 2016, and ends at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 31, 2016.

The filing period for presidential elector candidates begins at 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 17, 2016, and ends at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, August 23, 2016, for minor party and independent candidates. The certification deadline for major party presidential elector candidates is August 29, 2016. Note: Filing offices will be closed Monday, May 30, 2016, in observance of Memorial Day.

Candidates may file in person or by mail between 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 17, 2016, and 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 31, 2016. Note: Filing offices will be closed Monday, May 30, 2016 in observance of Memorial Day. Filings will be accepted in the Offices of the Secretary of State and the St. Louis County Auditor – Room 214, Duluth Courthouse, 100 North 5th Avenue West, Duluth, MN, 55802 (see below listing to determine where to file). Candidates who will be absent from the state during the filing period may arrange to file in person during the seven days immediately preceding the candidate's absence from the state, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, §204B.09, subdivision 1a.

Candidates for the following federal offices must file with the Secretary of State, State Office Building, Room 180, 100 Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., St. Paul, MN, 55155-1299.
