**SUBJ: FLU SHOTS - NORTH AREA EMPLOYEES**

Flu vaccinations will be offered to all St. Louis County and ARC employees, spouses, and dependents at no cost, including a late afternoon clinic. In addition, flu vaccinations will also be offered to all retirees and county-benefitted District Court employees actively participating in the St. Louis County health plan, at no cost.\*

There are three strains of flu being targeted with this year's vaccine: A/California (H1N1-like virus), A/Victoria (H3N2-like virus), and the B/Wisconsin. The H1N1 is the same component that was in last year's vaccine, but the other two components are new to the vaccine this year.
